Protection is not just about the equipment we provide—it is also about empowering people with the right information and building a stronger safety culture together.

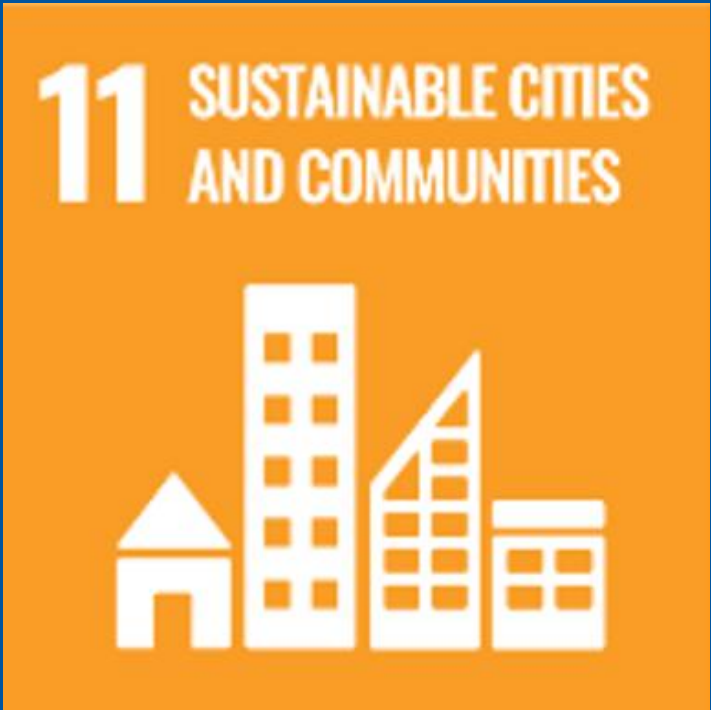

Project Highlights



From Concept to Safer Practice



Since 2019, DEREKDUCK has participated in a cross-sector initiative involving industry, government, and academia to advance occupational safety in Taiwan, with different priorities addressed each year.

In 2025, the initiative focused on developing protective gear better suited to Taiwanese body shapes. As a protective clothing expert, DEREKDUCK contributed to the design process by supporting fit evaluation and usability improvements. The project collected 1,190 survey responses from workers experienced in chemical protective clothing use. Through multiple consultations and at least three prototype revisions, protective clothing designs tailored to Taiwanese users were finalized.

Once implemented, this initiative is expected to benefit more than 30,000 frontline workers, enhancing comfort, mobility, and protection in chemical handling environments.
